



## American Pool Inc - Columbia

Various locations throughout Maryland and Washington, D.C.

### Company and Location:

- **Company** - Swimming pool management company. Located on the East Coast, situated between Delaware, Washington D.C. and Virginia.
- **Weather** - Hot and humid during the day, warm and humid during the evening. Temperatures range between 70 and 100 degrees Fahrenheit (24-38 degrees Celsius)



### Job Positions:

- **Pool Attendant/Lifeguard** - Will be assigned a region and pool upon arrival. You are not guaranteed to live with your friends. Responsible for constant, dedicated surveillance and monitoring of pools to prevent accidents. Will need to rescue swimmers in danger, test the chlorine levels, safely handle pool chemicals, clean the pool and pool area (including bathroom), and administer CPR/first aid as needed.
- **Pay Rate** - \$10.25 per hour
- **Hours** - Average of 45 hours per week over the course of the program. Some weeks may be more, some weeks may be less. Modified pool schedule during first 2-3 weeks due to local school schedule.
- **Start/End Date:** May 24 - September 2, 2019



### Employment Conditions:

- Must be able to swim at least 100 – 300 yards (depending on training cert used), retrieve a 10lb brick from 8+ feet of water, & tread water for 2 minutes without using hands.
- Confident English speaking English skills for interacting with swimmers and pool patrons.
- Must be able to work outside in all weather conditions, will be exposed to heat, sun, and chlorine daily.
- Must pass Lifeguard Certification in your home country and re-test upon arrival.
- Must pass pool operator exam or retest upon arrival, cost (up to \$40) will be payroll deducted.
- Will be tested regularly (and without notice) on lifesaving, CPR and First Aid.
- **BONUS:** \$50 bonus on 2<sup>nd</sup> paycheck if you arrive trained and start work on your DS 2019 start date
- **ARRIVAL PICK UP:** FREE bus pick up 1 time per day from Dulles Airport (IAD), May 20<sup>th</sup> – May 24<sup>th</sup>.
- **Uniform:** is required and will cost approximately \$65 (payroll deducted)
- **Social Security Number:** 7-10 days after you check into the program you will apply for a social security card. You will be able to work before you receive your card.

### Housing and Transportation:

- **Overview of housing situation** - Located in the area where you will work. Basic furnished apartment or hotel with kitchen. You will be responsible to keep your unit clean and to purchase all cleaning supplies and any additional utensils/amenities desired. A suggestion is to split these upon arrival with your roommates.
- **Housing Fees** - \$115.00 per week, payroll deducted.
- **Additional Housing Fees** - Housing deposit of \$200.00 is due prior to arrival. Each unit will have a monthly utility allowance, \$100 for 2 bedroom, \$140 for 3 bedroom. Excess utilities over this allowance will be split between residents and payroll deducted. One time linen fee of \$40.00 will be payroll deducted, non-refundable. Includes: sheets, towel, pillow, and blanket.
- **Transportation** - You will walk, bike, bus or take public transportation to work each day.
